The North American Training Lodge recently proposed a military-like training facility in the Town of Farmington, NH (which was unanimously voted against). Their proposal included:

- 4 handgun firing ranges
- 300-yard & 800-yard rifle ranges
- Nighttime training
- C4 & explosive training
- Tree level helicopter assists

The North American Training Lodge has now stated that it wants to have a military-like training facility in the Town of Groton, NH.

The following concerns have been raised, will the:

- Real estate values fall
- Quality of life change
- Local economy suffer
- Environment suffer
- Noise **adversely** affect your health & well being?

“I don’t deny that there’s going to be some noise. That’s a reality,” Gifford said. “But there’s noise in the areas of airports, drag strips and Lee Speedway.”
